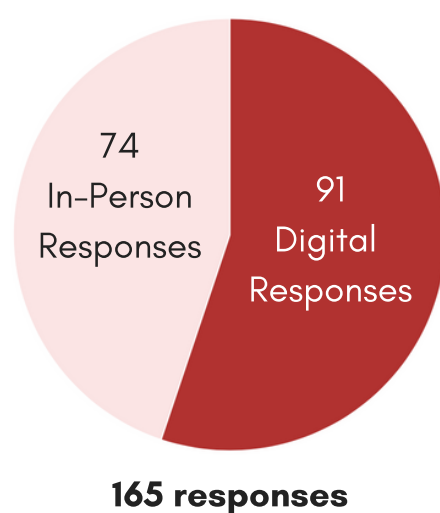


CAMROSE PRIMARY CARE NETWORK MATERNITY EXPERIENCE SURVEY RESULTS



WE ASKED

- What could have been better?

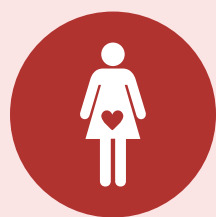


WE HEARD

80% rated their prenatal care from the Camrose PCN Prenatal Clinic team as **satisfactory or higher** and **83%** rated their overall maternity care as **satisfactory or higher**.



77% told us they value care that is delivered in relationship-based **Continuity of Carer** models (where they have the same primary caregiver for pregnancy, labour and birth, and in the weeks after birth)



77% said they want to have **choice** and to be able to make informed decisions about their care, and for their care to be **personalized** to their unique circumstances, wishes and values



39% told us that maternity care needs to address their **mental health** and wellbeing, just as much as their physical health



44% said they need high-quality **infant feeding** support to get feeding off to the best start to ensure keep mom and baby well in the postpartum period



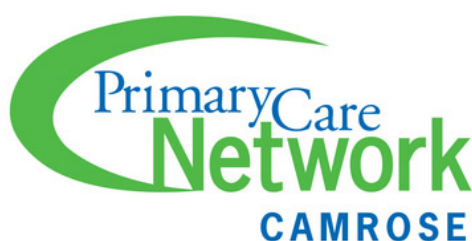
37% said that **geography** makes it difficult for some women to access the right care at the right time
