

# **WE ASKED**



- What was good about your maternity care?
- What could have been better?



#### 165 responses

## **WE HEARD**



80% rated their prenatal care from the Camrose PCN Prenatal Clinic team as satisfactory or higher and 83% rated their overall maternity care as satisfactory or higher.



77% told us they value care that is delivered in relationshipbased Continuity of Carer models (where they have the same primary caregiver for pregnancy, labour and birth, and in the weeks after birth)



77% said they want to have **choice** and to be able to make informed decisions about their care, and for their care to be personalized to their unique circumstances, wishes and values



39% told us that maternity care needs to address their mental health and wellbeing, just as much as their physical health



44% said they need high-quality infant feeding support to get feeding off to the best start to ensure keep mom and baby well in the postpartum period



37% said that geography makes it difficult for some women to access the right care at the right time
